COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) – Update #14 as at 1.00pm on Monday 19 April


We are buoyed by the low number of locally acquired cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) within Australia. There have been no locally acquired COVID cases in Victoria for 52 days and all areas of Australia are now green zones under Victoria's 'traffic light' travel permit system. Please note that as per government requirements, all students returning to Victoria for the start of Term 2 from green zones still require a permit to enter Victoria; this information supports the speed of Victoria's response should the public health situation in any location change.
