### **Boarding**


Regrettably, as at the time of writing we have still not been advised by Government authorities regarding the requirements for boarding operations. I appreciate that families need this information to make informed decisions about the next six-week period and acknowledge the frustrations felt at this time.

Please be assured that we have a team of staff standing by to assess the implications of the requirements for GGS and we will communicate with you as promptly as possible.

We appreciate too that families have different needs at this unsettling time. If you wish to make arrangements for your child to leave Corio, we are planning structured travel arrangements for Saturday 8 August; this avoids further disruption to learning and living arrangements, and enables greater time for us to process the imminent release of Government guidelines. Head of Campus, Steven Church, will provide further information shortly.

Despite the ongoing uncertainties, it is worth celebrating that thanks to our extraordinarily resilient and responsive staff, Corio and Timbertop boarders are safe and well together (complete with hail and snow respectively!).
