Academic Scholarship Terms and Conditions

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 To be eligible for an Academic scholarship at Geelong Grammar School, applicants must be:
 - 1.1.1 a new student entering into Years 9 or 10, or
 - 1.1.2 a current student entering into Years 9 or 10.
- 1.2 Applicants must be Australian or New Zealand citizens or holders of an Australian Permanent Resident Visa.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1 Academic scholarships are awarded based on an independent scholarship examination and an interview at the discretion of the Admissions Manager or delegate. Scholarship examination results from other schools are not able to be transferred.
- 2.2 Each application is evaluated on an individual basis and the applicant's merits. All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their scholarship application. Successful applicants will be determined at the discretion of the School and all decisions regarding successful scholars are final.

3. STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- 3.1 Students awarded scholarships are required to contribute fully to the life of the School, maintaining academic and behavioural standards and an overall positive contribution to the learning community. The School reserves the right to review the performance of the scholarship award holder at any time and discontinue the scholarship in circumstances where the terms of the scholarship have not been met.
- 3.2 All students who are scholarship holders must exhibit behaviour of the highest calibre.

4. SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AND ACCEPTANCE

- 4.1 The value of an Academic Scholarship may be up to the value of 50% of day or boarding fees. The final level of award is determined based on the performance of the individual applicant in the examination and, if shortlisted, interview.
- 4.2 Awards of over 50% are made in exceptional circumstances. In such cases, parents will be asked to provide financial information to determine the additional level of award that may be provided.
- 4.2 The scholarship award applies to the relevant Geelong Grammar School day or boarding fees as applicable, but not to uniforms, private vocal or instrumental lessons, textbooks, excursions, sundry charges or other personal items.
- 4.3 Successful recipients will be required to make payment of the Application and Enrolment Fees upon acceptance of the Scholarship. Successful recipients of a Scholarship who are current Geelong Grammar School students, are not required to pay these fees.
- 4.4 All scholarships are awarded on the expectation that the scholarship recipient will complete their schooling at Geelong Grammar School up to and including Year 12. If a student is withdrawn from the School prior to the completion of Year 12, all scholarship funds awarded must be repaid in full. The School at its sole discretion may elect to waive this requirement in extenuating circumstances.
- 4.5 By accepting the Scholarship award, students and parents consent to the usage of the scholarship recipient's name, image and profile to be used for the purposes of marketing and promotion of the School's scholarship programme. This may include for publication in School newsletters, external newspapers, magazines and websites (including the School's website) and social media. Such publication will go beyond the School community and may extend beyond the duration of the scholarship recipient's education at the School.
- 4.6 These Terms and Conditions should be read in conjunction with the School's Conditions of Entry and Business Notices, as amended from time to time.
