Media Statement re: sexual consent education in response to query from the Herald Sun

Background: Past Geelong Grammar School (GGS) students have added their stories to more than 3,000 responses to a petition regarding sexual consent education in schools.

At GGS, we are guided by the <u>Resilience</u>, <u>Rights and Respectful Relationships</u> (<u>RRR</u>) learning materials developed by the Victorian Government.

In addition, we teach these important topics at every year level and engage external experts to assist with educating students about respectful relationships, including consent.

The Navigate (Years 7-8) and Pathways (Years 10-12) frameworks are taught across all secondary levels and are underpinned by our GGS student wellbeing model.
