COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) - Update #15 as at 7.00pm on Wednesday 28 April

We continue to evolve our risk mitigation steps in response to COVID-19 and prioritise the health, safety and wellbeing of our students and staff. Our two-week planning cycle enables rapid adaptation of campus-specific measures as appropriate. Consequently, we continue to require all students and staff at our Corio campus to complete our Daily COVID-19 Health Questionnaire and all visitors to our Corio Campus to use the GGS QR code to self-assess for COVID-19 symptoms and risk factors before entering the campus. These measures reflect the scale of our boarding operations at Corio and the level of movement on and off campus, including APS Sport and Family Day on Sunday 2 May.

We gratefully anticipate the assistance of all those attending Family Day at our Corio Campus by checking in with the GGS QR Code to support contact tracing. This is a requirement for the School's compliance with the applicable COVIDSafe Low Risk Tier 2 Public Event Plan.

As of 29 April, the Daily COVID-19 Health Questionnaire is currently not a requirement at Bostock House, Timbertop and Toorak campuses.

Interstate Travel Requirements

Victoria's Chief Health Officer declared that as of today, Wednesday 28 April, Metropolitan Perth and the Peel region has moved from designated red zones to orange zones under Victoria's 'traffic light' travel permit system. People travelling from an orange zone must obtain a permit and isolate, be tested within 72 hours, and stay isolated until they receive a negative result. Permits can be obtained at Service Victoria.
