COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) – Update #16 as at 4.00pm on Friday 7 May

We are closely monitoring the locally acquired cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) in New South Wales and the resultant tightening of social distancing restrictions for the Greater Sydney region (including Wollongong, Central Coast and Blue Mountains). We are particularly attentive of any changes to Victoria's 'traffic light' travel permit system. Greater Sydney is currently designated as a green zone. People travelling from a green zone are still required to obtain a permit to enter Victoria. Permits can be obtained at [Service Victoria](#).


All areas across Australia and New Zealand are currently designated as green zones, with the exception of the Perth metropolitan area and Peel region, which remain a designated orange zone. People travelling from a designated orange zone must apply for a permit to enter Victoria, be tested for COVID-19 within 72 hours of arrival and remain in self-quarantine until they receive a negative test result.
