COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) - Update #19 as at 6.00pm on Wednesday 26 May

We continue to closely monitor the COVID-19 outbreak in Melbourne's northern suburbs and any changes to the <u>COVIDSafe settings</u> that apply across metropolitan Melbourne. We are refining our highly precautionary and proportionate risk mitigation steps and have restricted non-essential visitors to all four of our campuses.

Public exposure sites

The Department of Health (DoH) is actively identifying and updating its list of <u>public exposure sites</u>. We encourage our community to monitor risk locations, particularly if you have attended a recent event, such as Derby Day at The Geelong College or Discovery Day at our Corio campus. It is vital that our community follows the DoH guidelines for testing and isolation: if you have visited a public exposure site during the times listed and/or if you are experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms, however mild, please test and isolate until further direction is provided.

Similarly, we urge our community to continue to support QR Code check-in measures when visiting venues and facilities where visitors are required to check-in. This record keeping is an important tool for contact tracing and helping us to stay safe.

Our ongoing vigilance and compliance remain a necessity and will continue to serve our School well.

As ever, the School will communicate swiftly and accurately with our community as the situation evolves and more information is provided by the Victorian Government.
