COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) - Update #29 as at 3.30pm on Wednesday 14 July

Notwithstanding the uncertainty of the Delta COVID-19 variant outbreaks across Australia, and particularly in Greater Sydney, we have been uplifted by the positive and purposeful start to Semester 2 across our four campuses (both on campus and remotely). Public Exposure Sites

We urge our community to check the updated list of <u>public exposure sites</u> published on the Victorian Government's COVID-19 website, with particular reference to Level 2 of the MCC Members' Reserve at the Carlton v Geelong AFL game on Saturday 10 July, which has been listed as a Tier 2 exposure site. Anyone who has visited this location at that time should urgently be tested, then isolate until confirmation of a negative result.
