

ADDENDUM TO STUDENT ENROLMENT AGREEMENT

COVID-19 SPECIFIC CONDITIONS, TERM 1, 2023

- 1. Parents and/or legal guardians (**Parents**) of all students returning to Geelong Grammar School (the **School**) acknowledge and accept these **COVID-19 Specific Conditions** in addition to the School's Domestic Student Enrolment Agreement (as published).
- 2. The **COVID-19 Specific Conditions** are required to support the School to actively mitigate the risk of infection and the potential of reinfection cycles.

3. RETURN TO CAMPUS AT BOSTOCK HOUSE AND TOORAK

- 3.1. Parents acknowledge that if the student has symptoms consistent with a flu-like illness, the student should remain off campus and if on campus, the student will need to be collected as soon as able by their Parents or Emergency Contact.
- 3.2. Parents acknowledge that the student's return to campus will be subject to the student returning a negative COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) result. This COVID-19 RAT will be conducted by the School.

4. RETURN TO CAMPUS AT CORIO (BOARDING STUDENTS)

- 4.1. Students will undergo a COVID-19 RAT:
 - 4.1.1. in the event the student has symptoms consistent with a flu-like illness;
 - 4.1.2. if the School requires surveillance testing; and/or
 - 4.1.3. upon return to campus following an isolation period.
- 4.2. If the student returns a positive COVID-19 RAT result, the student will be isolated and will need to be collected as soon as able by their Parents or Emergency Contact.
- 4.3. Parents acknowledge that the student's return to campus will be subject to the student returning a negative COVID-19 RAT result. This COVID-19 RAT will be conducted by the School.

5. RETURN TO CORIO (DAY AND DAY BOARDING STUDENTS)

- 5.1. Parents acknowledge that if the student has symptoms consistent with a flu-like illness, the student should remain off campus and if on campus, the student will need to be collected as soon as able by their Parents or Emergency Contact.
- 5.2. Parents acknowledge that the student's return to campus will be subject to the student returning a negative COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) result. This COVID-19 RAT will be conducted by the School.

6. RETURN TO CAMPUS AT TIMBERTOP

- 6.1. Parents acknowledge that the student's commencement on campus will be subject to both the student and the Parents (or those persons accompanying the student on to campus) returning a negative COVID-19 RAT result immediately prior to their arrival on campus. This rapid antigen testing is to be undertaken by the Parents, student or persons accompanying the student on to campus, prior to attending on campus and at their own expense.
- 6.2. Students will undergo a COVID-19 RAT:
 - 6.2.1. on the student's first night on campus;
 - 6.2.2. in the event the student has symptoms consistent with a flu-like illness;
 - 6.2.3. if the School requires surveillance testing; and/or
 - 6.2.4. upon return to campus following an isolation period.
- 6.3. If the student returns a positive COVID-19 RAT result, the student will be isolated and will need to be collected as soon as able by their Parents or Emergency Contact.
- 6.4. Parents acknowledge that the student's return to campus will be subject to the student returning a negative COVID-19 RAT result. This COVID-19 RAT will be conducted by the School.
